This report is a count of people experiencing homelessness on a specific night in January.

On January 27, 2016 volunteers throughout SC surveyed people who were sleeping outside and in shelters to estimate how many people experience homelessness on any given night. This summarizes what they found.



Men 35-61 years old comprise the largest proportion of people experiencing homelessness

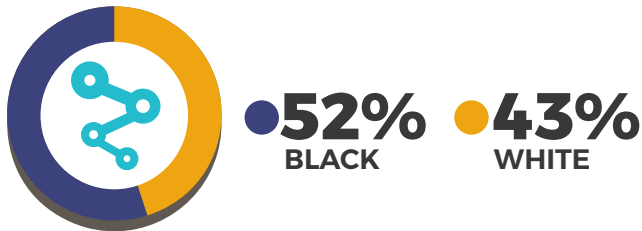

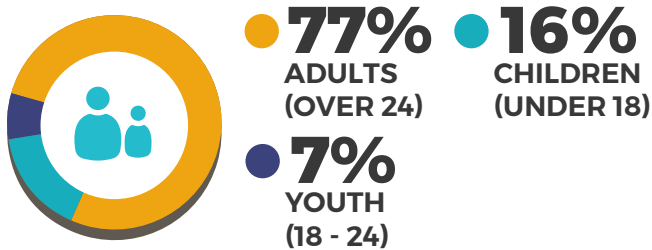
